


countries between the dates 25-28 October, 2017, in Istanbul.

Turkey Won 10 Awards in AsiaStar 2017

AsiaStar 2017 results determining "the best of the best packaging in Asia" were announced. Turkey won 3 AsiaStar awards while the young designers successfully representing Turkey in the student category came home with 7 awards.

AsiaStar, which is also known as "The Packaging Oscar of Asia", is the international packaging competition organized every year by Asian Packaging Federation. Winners of AsiaStar 2017 were recently announced. A total of 232 applications were processed for AsiaStar 2017 from Bangladesh, Indonesia, India, Japan, Korea, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Thailand and Turkey. A total of 11 applications were sent from Turkey, 3 of which are actual products and 8 are student projects. Turkish companies received 3 AsiaStar awards in Consumer Products and Packaging Materials and Components categories. Turkish young designers ranked in 'National Packaging Design Student Competition 2017' won 7 awards in the Student category of AsiaStar 2017. As a result, our representatives brought home a total of 10 awards from AsiaStar 2017.



Transportation of Fruits and Vegetables without Packaging will be Banned!



The Communiqué on the Standards for Wholesale and Retail Trade of Fruits and Vegetables" published in the Turkish Official Gazette on October 3, 2017 with the order of the Ministry of Customs and Trade has become effective. According to this new regulation which sets standards for wholesale and retail trade of fruits and vegetables, transportation of fruits and vegetables without packaging will not be allowed starting from the beginning of 2018.

The long standing questions which were left unanswered about packaging of fruits and vegetables during transport were finally answered. The Communiqué on the Standards for Wholesale and Retail Trade of Fruits and Vegetables" published in the Turkish Official Gazette on October 3, 2017 with the order of the Ministry of Customs and Trade regulates many aspects of transportation, storage and packaging of fruits and vegetables.

Pharmaceutcial Packaging Making Life Easier for Partially-Sighted Citizens

The Turkish regulation came into force last April obligates Braille engravings on pharmaceutical packaging. Pharmaceutical companies have until the end of 2018 to fully carry this regulation into action. Through packaging with Braille engravings, it is hoped to provide convenience for our partially-sighted citizens while buying pharmaceuticals. This past April, Turkish Ministry of Health issued



a bylaw stating that all names on pharmaceutical packaging will be written in Braille for partially-sighted citizens. Within the scope of "Packaging Information and Packaging Inserts of Pharmaceutical Products for Human Use and their Follow Up Regulations", companies were granted time until 31/12/2018 to apply Braille on all medication packages. Warning About Unpacked Candy & Chocolate

Turkish Packaging Manufacturers Association (ASD) warned consumers about unpacked candy, Turkish delight, and chocolates. Mr. Zeki Saribekir, the President of ASD, underlined that all unpacked foodstuffs including unpacked candies carry great risks and said, "It is impossible to think about health and hygiene in unpacked foods. Do not let cheap prices deceive you into buying unpacked candies."

Candy, Turkish delight and chocolate sales peak before Eid al-Fitr (Ramadan Feast) each year, which eventually causes under the counter sales of low quality and unhealthy products. Unpacked products like candy, Turkish delight and chocolate preferred by customers because they are cheaper or deemed fresher are usually extremely unhealthy and harmful. Unpacked candies and chocolates may be in contact with pests or rodents and cause great risks towards human health.
